
Forecast Summary

- It is estimated that an average of 160 to 240 jobs will be lost in Trinity County during 2020. Job losses will be heavy in the first half of the year.
- Employment losses will be largest in leisure services, retail, and government.
- The unemployment rate averaged 5.5 percent in 2019. It will average between 8 percent and 11 percent during the 2020 calendar year.
- The Trinity County population is expected to decline during most of the 2020-2025 forecast period.
- Home values are not expected to show much change in 2020 or 2021.
- More new homes are expected to be built during the 2020-2025 period than were built in the 2014-2019 period.


Job Growth


- Total employment in the County will decline by at least 6 percent in 2020. This is an annual average change from 2019.
- In 2021 and 2022, Trinity County is expected to re-gain many of the jobs that were lost during the Coronavirus Recession.





Manufacturing Employment

- In April and May of 2020, during the Coronavirus Recession, a small number of manufacturing workers lost their jobs.
- On an annual average basis, total manufacturing employment is expected to contract by 10 to 20 jobs in 2020.
- The manufacturing industry is expected to rebound relatively quickly, surpassing pre-recession employment levels by 2021 or 2022.










Retail Trade Employment

- The retail sector is expected to lose up to 50 jobs in 2020 on an annual average basis.
- A large share of Trinity County retail jobs are in grocery stores.
- Trinity County has a small number of national retail chain establishments, such as CVS and Dollar General.
- Retail trade jobs will return after in-store shopping is permitted in a sustained way.

Private Education and Healthcare Employment

 There were almost 300 healthcare and social assistance jobs in Trinity County in 2019.




- Healthcare jobs were recession proof during the 2008-2009 financial crisis. However, some non-essential medical offices had to close in 2020, and others reduced employment levels because resources were not being utilized as envisioned to support Coronavirus patients.
- Jobs in social assistance, including industries like childcare, housing shelters, and non-medical care for senior citizens, were mostly classified as essential during the shutdowns. Nevertheless, there were layoffs at institutions with revenue shortfalls.
- There are very few jobs in private educational institutions in Trinity County.


Leisure and Hospitality Employment

- In 2019, Trinity County had almost 350 jobs in restaurants, hotels, bars, gyms, and recreational facilities.
- Approximately 25 percent of workers were laid off in March and April of 2020. Another 20 to 30 percent had their hours cut or were furloughed without pay.
- Leisure and hospitality employment is expected to rebound swiftly in 2021 and 2022, but it is unclear if all jobs will be re-gained by the end of the 2020-2025 forecast period.

Government Employment

- Government agencies are expected to lose revenue from taxes and fees in 2020, and these revenue shortfalls will likely persist into 2021.
- When government agencies need to reduce expenditures on salaries, many workers are expected to be given unpaid furlough





days that are distributed throughout the year, and many staffing reductions could be the result of hiring freezes rather than layoffs.


 However, if revenue shortfalls are severe and Congress does not appropriate funding to mitigate these shortfalls, government agencies may have no choice but to issue layoffs.


Population Growth


- The Trinity County population is expected to decline during most years between 2020 and 2025.
- The number of people moving into Trinity County is expected to exceed the number of residents moving out between 2020 and


2025, which will prevent the overall population from declining more rapidly.

- Because Trinity County has an older population base, the number of deaths has exceeded the number of births for many years. This situation will persist into the forecast period, leading to overall population decline.
- Between 2020 and 2025, the population is expected to shrink at an annual average rate of 0.1 percent.
- By 2025, the population is forecast to fall below 13,400 residents.











Unemployment and Inflation Rates

- The unemployment rate in Trinity County averaged 5.5 percent in 2019, which was above the composite rate for the Northern California region.
- The unemployment rate is expected to average between 8 and 11 percent in 2020.
- The unemployment rate is expected to remain elevated for several years, but is likely to improve more quickly than after the 2008-2009 recession.
- Inflation decelerated in 2019 as energy prices declined and home prices increased more slowly than the previous year.
- Inflation is expected to be very low in 2020 but could accelerate in 2021 or 2022.



Home Prices and New Housing Production

- In 2019 the median home price in Trinity County was \$210,800
 The median price is not expected to change substantially in 2020 or 2021.
- In Trinity County, the typical household spends less than 25 percent of its pre-tax income on mortgage payments or rent.
- Along Coastal California, the typical household spends more than 35 percent of income on housing costs, and in very expensive markets like San Francisco, housing costs often account for more than 50 percent of income.
- From 2014 to 2019, an average of 35 new homes were started per year in Trinity County. All were single-family homes.
- Housing production is expected to average 40 to 50 units per year from 2020 to 2025, consisting primarily of single-family homes.
