

Forecast Summary

- On an annual average basis, approximately 80 to 100 jobs will be restored in Trinity County during 2021, representing most of the jobs that were lost in 2020.
- A complete recovery is expected by 2022.
- Over the 2021-2026 forecast period, total employment in Trinity County is expected to increase by approximately 200 jobs.
- Healthcare and leisure services will account for half of all net job creation over the forecast period.
- The local agriculture industry is very small, but agriculture employment will expand faster than any other sector as Trinity County cannabis growers continue to enter the legal market.
- The unemployment rate averaged 8.0 percent in 2020.
- The unemployment rate is forecast to average 5.6 percent in 2021 and 5.3 percent in 2022.
- The Trinity County population is expected to decline during the 2021-2026 forecast period, contributing to broad-based economic stagnation.

Job Growth


- Total employment in Trinity County will expand by 3.6 percent in 2021 on an annual average basis.
- Job growth is expected to decelerate and could flat-line during the second half of the forecast period.







Manufacturing Employment

- Trinity County manufacturing is concentrated in lumber production, and the largest employer is Trinity County Lumbar.
- Trinity County Lumbar is headquartered in Weaverville and was founded in 1947. The company's primary sawmill was destroyed several times by fires over the following decades, but has been rebuilt each time.
- As of 2021, the sawmill produced various types of lumbar out of Douglas fir and Hem fir trees, employing more than 100 workers.
- After a period of weakness that began in 2016, overall manufacturing employment is expected to remain relatively stable during the forecast period.








Private Education and Healthcare Employment

- Substantial job growth is expected in the healthcare sector over the 2021-2026 forecast period.
- The largest healthcare employer is Mountain Communities Healthcare District, which has 50 patient beds and treats more than 100 patients per month.
- In 2022 and 2023, employee recruitment will be the biggest risk to job growth. Hospitals and other healthcare facilities have struggled to fill open positions during the COVID-19 pandemic, meaning that job creation will depend on the willingness and ability of local residents to enter the healthcare workforce.
- In Trinity County, there are very few jobs in private educational institutions. Most teachers and education administrators work in the government sector.

Leisure and Hospitality Employment

- Trinity County has an expansive outdoor recreation industry.
 Visitors come to the county to boat on Trinity Lake, raft down Trinity River, and hike in the Trinity Alps Wilderness.
- The county also has approximately 25 hotels, 40 restaurants and food services establishments, and a handful of theaters and museums.
- In 2020, the leisure and hospitality sector lost approximately 20 percent of its workforce due to the Coronavirus Recession and related business/travel restrictions.
- Leisure and hospitality employment is expected to rebound slowly and a full recovery may not be observed during the 2021-2026 forecast period.





Agriculture Employment

- The legal agriculture industry in Trinity County is small, employing
 just 25 workers, but it is expected to expand rapidly as Trinity
 County cannabis growers enter the legal market and their
 employees begin to be counted in official labor market data.
- Cannabis is the most prominent agricultural commodity in the county, and the local cannabis industry is dominated by small farms and greenhouses.

- In Trinity County, there were approximately 500 active cultivation permits that were spread across 370 growers in 2021, indicating that the average grower managed less than an acre of land or greenhouse space.
- By contrast, large cannabis businesses were more prominent across the rest of California. In one of the most prominant cannabis counties - Santa Barbara County - approximately 1,600 permits were held by just 67 growers.
- The supply of legal cannabis in California has begun to exceed demand, and prices have declined dramatically since the industry was legalized.
- Anecdotal evidence suggests that small growers have struggled to adapt to lower prices.
- Legal cannabis production in Trinity County should continue to expand, but may ultimately depend on the ability of small operations to adapt to market fluctuations or merge into larger entities with better profit margins.


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

- The Trinity County population has declined relatively consistently since 2007, when it had almost 13,800 residents.
- As of 2020, Trinity County had 13,291 residents.
- Trinity County's population is much older than the statewide average, with a much higher share of residents over the age of 75.
- Because Trinity County has a large share of residents aged 75 and older, the number of deaths now exceeds the number of births.
- Between 2021 and 2026, the number of people moving into Trinity County is expected to exceed the number of residents moving out of the County, but because deaths will exceed births, the overall population will decline.
- Sustained population loss will put Trinity County at risk of economic stagnation.
 A declining population can reduce the number of consumers for






Net Migration



- local businesses, lead to lower demand for school teachers and government services, and constrain tax revenues.
- Over the long term (through 2030), the local labor market is not expected to generate a meaningful number of jobs, with population declines contributing to stagnant economic activity.











Unemployment and Inflation Rates

- The unemployment rate in Trinity County averaged 8.0 percent in 2020. It is expected to average 5.6 percent in 2021 and 5.3 percent in 2022.
- Inflation decelerated sharply in 2020, largely because energy prices declined when the demand for fuels plunged. It soared in 2021 and is expected to remain elevated for several years.
- Ultimately, inflation will reduce the purchasing power of households and negatively impact consumer confidence, limiting the growth potential of the economy in 2022.
- However, inflation will begin to decelerate as supply chains and the labor force are restored by the second half of the forecast period, eventually falling below 3 percent.



Home Prices and New Housing Production

- In 2020, the median home price in Trinity County was \$221,800, an increase of 5 percent from the previous year.
- The median price is expected to increase very quickly in 2021 as the number of homes on the market plummets and the number of house hunters grows.
- Price appreciation should slow down in 2022, but the median price could surpass \$275,000 by 2026.
- From 2015 to 2020, an average of 38 new homes were started per year. All were single-family homes.
- Housing production is expected to average 40 to 50 units per year from 2021 to 2026, consisting entirely of single-family homes.
