

Work to Begin February 12th on Beach Boulevard (State Route 39) for Construction of 22 New Bus Pads

ORANGE COUNTY – A project to install 22 new bus pads along Beach Boulevard (State Route 39) from Pacific Coast Highway (State Route 1) in Huntington Beach to State Route 91 in Buena Park will begin at 6 p.m. on Monday, February 12 with intermittent lane closures. At least one lane will be open in each direction at all times. Most construction work will be completed by Wednesday, March 14. Unforeseen operational factors or inclement weather may cause these times and dates to change.

Motorists are encouraged to check traffic conditions before they travel and download the free Caltrans QuickMap app, which integrates with Waze to provide real-time traffic information, help avoid congestion and reduce travel times.


