Full Closure of Victoria / 22nd Street On-Ramp To Southbound State Route 55

1/22 to 2/20

COSTA MESA – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will need to close the Victoria/22nd Street on-ramp to southbound SR-55 for 28 consecutive days starting Monday, January 22nd at 10:00 p.m. until Tuesday, February 20th at 5:00 a.m. The closure is needed to install a permanent guardrail and a concrete barrier with barrier slab.

Detours are as follows when heading:

- WB on 22nd St. turn left onto Newport Blvd., straight to SB SR-55
- EB on Victoria St. turn right onto Newport Blvd., straight to SB SR-55
- SB on Newport Blvd continue straight until it converges onto SB SR-55

Motorists are encouraged to check traffic conditions before they travel and download the free Caltrans QuickMap app, which integrates with Waze to provide real-time traffic information, help avoid congestion and reduce travel times.

Caltrans is working quickly to perform this work while reducing impact to the traveling public. We appreciate your patience. Please slow down and use extra caution through the construction area.
