Reduced Lanes on State Route 74 / Ortega Highway At Hot Springs Canyon Road 11/13 to 11/17 and 11/20 to 11/21

San Juan Capistrano – From Monday, November 13 to Friday, November 17 and Monday, November 20 to Tuesday, November 21, Caltrans will be doing night work on State Route 74 (Ortega Highway) near Hot Springs Canyon Road, about 12 miles east of Interstate 5. The work will take place from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. and will reduce traffic flow from two lanes to one lane. Construction activities will occur under flagging operations, allowing one direction of traffic to pass at a time. Delays are expected, please plan accordingly.

Detours are:

From I-5:

South I-5 to east SR-76 to north I-15.

North I-5 to SR-55 to east SR-91 to south I-15.

From I-15:

North I-15 to westbound SR-91 to south SR-55 to south I-5.

South I-15 to westbound SR-76 to north I-5.

To ensure the safety of the traveling public and workers in a construction zone, please remember to “slow for the cone zone”, “move over”, be alert, proceed with caution, and be mindful that fines are doubled in construction zones.
