Project Description

Caltrans will begin a maintenance project replacing sidewalks, curbs, and driveways at various points along SR-90 Imperial Highway in the cities of La Habra, Brea, Fullerton, and Placentia.

The work also includes refreshing crosswalk striping, installing pedestrian barrier and signs; installing pedestrian countdown heads and replacing damaged sidewalk.

Project Benefits

This project fulfills Caltrans goals of safety and health by providing a safer route for pedestrians, and thereby encouraging healthy activity and multimodal travel. It also fulfills Caltrans' goal of sustainability, livability and the economy by encouraging sustainable modes of travel and reducing our carbon footprint.

Project Details

This is a \$4.5M SHOPP (State Highway Operation and Protection Program) project.

Preliminary work begins June 2016 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. to remove soil samples.

Proposed construction begins late Fall 2017.

Planned Closures

There are no anticipated lane closures or driveway closures during preliminary work. Once actual construction begins in Fall 2017 Caltrans will provide additional information.
