

Caltrans District 9 2016 Current Construction Projects

Mono County

Adobe Chip Seal Project

- Construction to begin on May 25, 2016 and will be complete in July 2016.
- Pavement Preservation Project
- The project location is in Mono County, US Hwy 6 in Benton and on SR 120, 16 miles west of Benton to River Springs Road.
- Approximately ½' of new asphalt with a chipped rock is added to the roadway which will extend the pavement life.
- Contractor is VSS International from Sacramento, CA.
- Working hours: Monday-Friday, 6:00 am to 7:00 pm.
- Traffic Impact during construction: Reversing traffic control with flaggers and a pilot car. Expect up to 20 minute delays. Traffic is encounter loose gravel and will follow a pilot car at 15 mph when driving through the 2 mile long construction zone.

All Over Signs Project

- Construction to begin on August 1, 2016 and will be complete in August 2016.
- Replace existing signs with updated signs.
- Project construction is in various locations in Inyo, Mono and Kern Counties.
- Contractor is C C F G Construction from Sonora, CA.
- Working hours: Monday-Thursday, 5:00 am to 9:00 pm and Friday's 5:00 am to 3:00 pm.
- Traffic Impact during construction: Reversing traffic control with flaggers and a pilot car. Expect up to 20 minute delays.

Bridgeport Culverts Project

- Construction to begin on July 18, 2016 and will be complete in November 2016.
- Culvert replacement project
- The project location is in Mono County, near Bridgeport, CA.
- Contractor is William Kanayan Construction, Inc. from Rim Forest, CA.
- Working hours: Mon – Thurs 6:00 am – 8:00 pm, Friday 6:00 am – 3:00 pm
- Traffic Impact during construction: Daily lane closures using reversing one-way traffic with flaggers at each location. Delays up to 20 minutes.

Green Lakes CAPM Project

- Construction to begin on August 29, 2016 and will be complete in November 2016.
Pavement Preservation Project
- The project location is in Mono County, on US Hwy 395 near Bridgeport from SR270 to Jack Sawyer Road (postmile 69.8 to 76).
- The top layer of the pavement surface is being ground off, recycled with new hot mix asphalt and a new overlay placed on top.
- Contractor is Herback General Engineering from Minden, NV.
- Working hours: Mon – Thurs 7:00 am – 8:00 pm, Friday 7:00 am – 3:00 pm
- Traffic Impact during construction: Daily lane closures using reversing one-way traffic with flaggers and a pilot car. Delays up to 20 minutes.

Caltrans District 9 2016 Current Construction Projects

Inyo Mono Bridge Transition Rail Project

- Construction began on April 11, 2016 and will be complete in November 2016.
- Safety Project
- There are 25 locations for this project in Inyo & Mono Counties.
- Construction consists of modifying the concrete barriers and upgrading the end treatments.
- Contractor: Peterson-Chase Engineering Construction, Inc. from Irvine, CA
- Working hours: Monday-Friday: 6:00 am to 6:00 pm.
- Traffic Impact during construction: Reversing traffic control with flaggers. Expect up to 20 minute delays.

Lee Vining Rockfall Project

- Construction for season 2 is to begin in July, 2016 and completed in the fall of 2016.
- Safety Project
- The project location is in Mono County, on US Hwy 395 near Lee Vining (postmile 52.3 to 53.7).
- 6 cut slopes are being reconstructed to include anchored mesh to stabilize the slopes to reduce rockfall, and includes a plant establishment program to reduce erosion, establish healthy soil, and promote successful revegetation..
- Contractor is Papich Construction Co., Inc. from Pismo Beach, CA.
- Working hours:
- Traffic impact during construction: 24/7 lane closure with K-railing using reversing traffic control with a temporary traffic signal system.

Mono Chip Seal Project

- Construction to begin on June 20, 2016 and will be complete in August 2016.
- Pavement Preservation Project
- The project location is in Mono County on:
 - SR 108 – from the junction of US Hwy 395 to the closure gate.
 - SR 270 – from the junction of US Hwy 395 to the closure gate.
 - SR 395 in various locations.
- The top layer of the pavement surface is being ground off, new hot mix asphalt mixed with rubberized chip seal and placed on top of the roadbed.
- Contractor is American Pavement Solutions, Inc. from Modesto, CA.
- Working hours: Monday-Thursday, 6:00 am to 8:00 pm and Friday's 6:00 am to 3:00 pm.
- Traffic Impact during construction:
 - 35 MPH speed advisory signs will be posted during the chip sealing operation.
 - SR 108 – Daily lane closures using reversing traffic control with flaggers and a pilot car. Expect up to 20 minute delays.
 - SR 270 – Daily lane closures using reversing traffic control with flaggers and a pilot car. Expect up to 20 minute delays.
 - US Hwy 395 – Minimal to zero delays.

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Walker CAPM Project

- Construction to begin July 2016.
- Pavement Preservation Project
- The project location is in Mono County, on US Hwy 395 postmile 106.3 to 120.49.
- The top layer of the pavement surface is being ground off, recycled with new hot mix asphalt and a new overlay placed on top.
- Project not yet awarded.

- Construction to begin on August 1, 2016 and will be complete in August 2016.
- Replace existing signs with updated signs.
- Project construction is in various locations in Inyo, Mono and Kern Counties.
- Contractor is C C F G Construction from Sonora, CA.
- Working hours: Monday-Thursday, 5:00 am to 9:00 pm and Friday's 5:00 am to 3:00 pm.
- Traffic Impact during construction: Reversing traffic control with flaggers and a pilot car. Expect up to 20 minute delays.

Chicago Valley Thin Blanket Project

- Construction to begin on August 15, 2016 and will be complete in October 2016.
- Pavement Preservation Project
- The project location is in Inyo County 6 miles east of Shoshone to 2.2 west of the Nevada state line.
- The top layer of the pavement surface is being ground off, recycled with new hot mix asphalt and a new overlay placed on top.
- Contractor is Qualcon Contractors, Inc. from Minden, NV.
- Working hours: Monday-Thursday, 6:00 am to 8:00 pm and Friday's 6:00 am to 3:00 pm.
- Traffic Impact during construction: Reversing traffic control with flaggers and a pilot car. Expect up to 20 minute delays.

Dirty Socks Cold In Place Recycling Project

- Construction to begin on June 20, 2016 and will be complete in August 2016.
- Pavement Preservation Project
- The project location is in Inyo County near Olancho from 5.4 miles west of Coso Wash Bridge to 0.9 west of Coso Wash Bridge.
- The top layer of the pavement surface is being ground off, recycled with new hot mix asphalt and a new overlay placed on top.
- Contractor is Sully-Miller Contracting Company from Brea, CA.
- Working hours: Monday-Thursday, 5:00 am to 9:00 pm and Friday's 5:00 am to 3:00 pm
- Traffic Impact during construction: Reversing traffic control with flaggers and a pilot car.. Expect up to 20 minute delays.

Caltrans District 9 2016 Current Construction Projects

Haiwee Shoulder Widening

- Construction began on January 25, 2015 and will be complete in June 2016.
- Safety Project
- The project location is in Inyo County on US Hwy 395 from Rose Valley Ranch Road to 1.0 miles north of the LA Aqueduct Bridge (postmile 20.3 to 22.3).
- Construction consists of widening the southbound outside shoulder to 10 feet, flattening fill and cut slopes on both sides of the southbound lanes, extending culvers, and removing large boulders from within the recovery zone. Widening the outside shoulder will provide a paved surface for motorists to pull off the traveled way, establish a separate pathway for cyclists and pedestrians, provide errant drivers more paved recovery area, and allow maintenance crews to safely maintain the roadway.
- Contractor: Cutting Edge Concrete Services from Oro Grande CA.
- Working hours: Mon – Fri 7:00 am – 4:30 pm,
- Traffic Impact during construction: No delays but expect a single lane and shoulder to be closed during construction.

Independence Material Site Project

- Construction to begin on August 1, 2016.
- Material site reclamation
- The project location is in Inyo County near Independence, CA
- Contractor is William Kanayan Construction, Inc. from Rim Forest, CA.
- Traffic Impact during construction: None

Independence Median Paving Project

- Construction to begin 2016.
- Pavement Preservation Project
- The project location is in Inyo County, on US Hwy 395 postmile 76 to 77.
- The top layer of the pavement surface is being ground off, recycled with new hot mix asphalt and a new overlay placed on top.
- Project not yet awarded.

Inyo / Kern Commuter Message Signs Project

- Construction to begin late June 1, 2016 and will be complete in late September 2016.
- Install Commuter Message Signs in 4 locations.
 - Location 1 – On SR 14 near Rosamond
 - Location 2 – On SR 58 near the junction of SR 14
 - Location 3 – On US Hwy 395 near Inyokern
 - Location 4 – On US Hwy 395 near Lone Pine
- Contractor is Peterson-Chase General Engineering Construction, Inc. from Irvine, CA.
- Traffic Impact during construction: Various lane closures in and around the work zone, with minimal delays.

Inyo / Mono Bridge Transition Rail Project

- Construction began on April 11, 2016 and will be complete in November 2016.
- Safety Project

Little Lake Thin Blanket Project

- Construction began on May 11, 2016 and will be complete in July 2016.
- Pavement Preservation Project
- The project location is in Inyo County, US Hwy 395 from the Kern County line to 1.0 mile south of the North Little Lake Road.
- The top layer of the pavement surface is being ground off and a new overlay placed on top.
- Contractor is Pave Tech Inc. from Vista, CA
- Working hours: Monday - Thursday 6:00 am to 8:00 pm and Fridays 6:00 am to 3:00 pm.
- Traffic Impact during construction: There will be daily lane closures. No delays anticipated.

Mill Creek Thin Blanket Project

- Construction to begin 2016.
- Pavement Preservation Project
- The project location is in Inyo County, on US Hwy 395 postmile R122.323 to R129.459.
- The top layer of the pavement surface is being ground off, recycled with new hot mix asphalt and a new overlay placed on top.
- Project not yet awarded.

Shoshone Cold In Place Recycle Project

- Construction began on May 10, 2016 and will be complete in October 2016.
- Pavement Preservation Project
- The project location is in Inyo County, SR 127 from the San Bernardino County Line to 4.6 miles north of the north junction of SR 178.
- The top layer of the pavement surface is being ground off, recycled with new hot mix asphalt and a new overlay placed on top.
- Contractor is Pave Tech Inc. from Vista, CA
- Working hours: Monday - Thursday 6:00 am to 8:00 pm and Fridays 6:00 am to 3:00 pm.
- Traffic Impact during construction: There is one way traffic control with flaggers and a pilot car. Expect up to 20 minute delays along SR 127.

Kern County

All Over Signs Project

- Construction to begin on August 1, 2016 and will be complete in August 2016.
- Replace existing signs with updated signs.
- Project construction is in various locations in Inyo, Mono and Kern Counties.
- Contractor is C C F G Construction from Sonora, CA.

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- Traffic Impact during construction: Reversing traffic control with flaggers and a pilot car. Monday-Thursday, 5:00 am to 9:00 pm and Friday's 5:00 am to 3:00 pm. Expect up to 20 minute delays.

Boron Overlay Project

- The project location is in Kern County, on SR 58 postmile R136 to R143.
- The top layer of the pavement surface is being ground off, recycled with new hot mix asphalt and a new overlay placed on top.

Inyo – Kern Commuter Message Signs Project

- Construction to begin late June 1, 2016 and will be complete in late September 2016.
- Install Commuter Message Signs in 4 locations.
 - Location 1 – On SR 14 near Rosamond
 - Location 2 – On SR 58 near the junction of SR 14
 - Location 3 – On US Hwy 395 near Inyokern
 - Location 4 – On US Hwy 395 near Lone Pine
- Contractor is Peterson-Chase General Engineering Construction, Inc. from Irvine, CA.
- Traffic Impact during construction: Various lane closures in and around the work zone, with minimal delays.

Johannesburg Resurfacing Project

- Construction to begin on May 17, 2016 and will be complete in August 2016.
- Pavement Preservation Project
- The project location is in Kern County, US Hwy 395 in Johannesburg from the San Bernardino County line to the junction of SR 178.
- The top layer of the pavement surface is being ground off, recycled with new hot mix asphalt and a new overlay placed on top.
- Contractor is Granite Construction from Bakersfield, CA.
- Working hours: Monday-Thursday, 5:00 am to 8:00 pm.
- Traffic Impact during construction: Reversing traffic control with flaggers and a pilot car. Expect up to 20 minute delays.

Tehachapi CAPM Project

- Construction to begin 2016.
- Pavement Preservation Project
- The project location is in Kern County, on SR 58 postmile R88.5 to R99.8.
- The top layer of the pavement surface is being ground off, recycled with new hot mix asphalt and a new overlay placed on top.
