NO MAJOR HIGHWAY ROADWORKSCHEDULED DURING THE MID-STATE FAIR

PASO ROBLES – During the California Mid-State Fair, any scheduled/planned roadwork on Highways 41, 46 and 101 is not expected to interfere with the access to the fair, taking place from Wednesday, July 18 through Sunday, July, 29.

Daytime paving roadwork consisting of alternating lane closures is scheduled weekdays on southbound Hwy. 101 in Atascadero (leaving the fair) from 9 am to 3 pm with minimal delays expected.

No other major roadwork on state highways in the Paso Robles area is planned through Sunday, July 29.
