## TAMC CONE ZONE REPORT

ROAD AND LANE CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR MAR. 25 – MAR. 31

MONTEREY COUNTY – Here are the major scheduled road and lane closures for Monterey County from **Sunday, March 25 through Saturday, March 31 – newest information is in red.** Please keep in mind that construction work is weather-dependent.

### Highway 1 Storm Repair Along the Big Sur Coast

Due to past slides, State Route 1 is now closed at the Ranger Station North Ragged Point Inn and at Mud Creek.

#### Highway 1 – Big Sur

Sections of Highway 1 at the following locations are now re-opened after the removal of debris from recent mudslides:

- Nacimiento-Ferguson Road to just south of Lucia Lodge
- Anderson Canyon Bridge

#### Highway 1 – Big Sur: March 26 – March 30

One lane closure along northbound and southbound Highway for bridge work will occur at Pfeiffer Canyon Bridge, Cow Cliffs and Big Creek Bridge in Big Sur, starting Monday, March 26 through Friday, March 30. Details are as follows:

- Monday, March 26-Friday, March 30, work along the right shoulder from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. at Pfeiffer Canyon Bridge with 5-minute delays expected.
- Tuesday, March 27-Thursday, March 29, one lane will be closed for bridge inspection work between Big Creek Bridge and Cow Cliffs from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. with 5-minute delays expected.
- Tuesday, March 27-Thursday, March 29, one lane will be closed for bridge inspection work at Cow Cliffs from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. with 5-minute delays expected.

#### Highway 1 – Monterey-Castroville: March 26 – March 30

The Caltrans Monterey Maintenance crew will provide lane closures for the California Conservation Core (CCC) to perform vegetation control in the center median along Highway 1 from Carmel to Castroville for five days, starting Monday, March 26, Caltrans officials have

announced. Details are as follows:

- Monday, March 26, closure of northbound #2 (right) lane at Carmel Valley Road in Carmel from 9 am to 2 pm with 5-minute delays expected.
- Monday, March 26-Friday, March 30, alternating moving lane closures on northbound and southbound Highway 1 between Casa Verde Way in Monterey to Merritt Street (Highway 183) in Castroville from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. with 5-minute delays expected.

### **Highway 68 – Salinas River Bridge: March 26 – March 30**

Daytime bridge work along Highway 68 between Spreckels Boulevard and Reservation Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.

### **Highway 101 – Greenfield: March 26 – March 30**

Daytime shoulder work along southbound & northbound Highway 101 from Harden Farms Road to Oak Avenue in Greenfield will occur from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

### **Highway 101 – Soledad: March 27**

The northbound # 2 (right) lane of Highway 101 between Route 146 and the Soledad overcrossing will be closed for fence repair work on Tuesday, March 27, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

### **Highway 101 – Salinas: March 26-27**

One lane of Highway 101 will be closed for guardrail repair work on Monday, March 26, - Thursday, March 29 on the following dates and times:

- The northbound #1 (left) lane of Highway 101 will be closed at Sanborn Road on Monday, March 26, from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- The southbound #1 (left) lane of Highway 101 at Boronda Road will be closed on Tuesday, March 27, from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- The northbound #2 (right) lane of Highway 101 at Ralph Lane will be closed on Thursday, March 29, from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

### **Highway 156 –Castroville: March 27**

Alternating lane closures will occur along westbound Highway 156 between the Castroville overcrossing and Castroville Blvd for emergency repair work on Tuesday, March 27, from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.

### **Highway 156 –Prunedale: March 29**

One-way traffic controls will be in place on eastbound and westbound Highway 156 at Cathedral Oak Road for guardrail repair work on Thursday, March 29 from 12 p.m. to 2 p.m.

### **Highway 198 – San Lucas**

The mudslide debris at the Intersection of Highway 198 and State Route 25 has been removed and the intersection is now open.
