SOUTHBOUND HIGHWAY 101 GUARDRAIL REPAIR IN SAN JUAN BAUTISTA—NEXT WEDNESDAY AND THURSDAY

SAN BENITO COUNTY – Crews will make guardrail on both lanes of **southbound** Hwy. 101 at Gannon Road in Juan Bautista for two days, next Wednesday, Jan. 25 and Thursday, Jan. 26, Caltrans officials have announced. Details are as follows:

- The southbound #2 (right) lane will be closed on Wednesday, Jan. 25.
- The southbound #1 (left) lane will be closed on Thursday, Jan. 26.
- Roadwork hours are from from 9 am to 1 pm each day.
- **Motorists can expect delays of up to 20 minutes and are encouraged to take an alternate route.**

Electronic message boards will be placed to inform motorists of roadwork. The CHP will assist with traffic control.

The guardrail was recently hit and damaged. Roadwork is expected to be completed by Thursday, Jan. 26, weather permitting, and roadwork is being done by Hollister Maintenance and Monterey Guardrail crews.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway construction zones.
