PUBLIC MEETING IN ARROYO GRANDE NEXT WEEK ON BRISCO-HALCYON ROAD INTERCHANGE MODIFICATIONS PROJECT

SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY– Caltrans and the City of Arroyo Grande Community Development Department will conduct a public workshop regarding the Brisco-Halcyon Road Interchange Modifications Project on Thursday, April 26, 2018 at the Arroyo Grande City Council Chambers at 215 East Branch Street from 6 pm until 8 pm.

This project proposes modifications and improvements to the US 101 intersections at Brisco-Halcyon Road, East Grand Avenue, and/or Camino Mercado in the City of Arroyo Grande to provide congestion relief, alleviate queuing, and improve the flow of traffic on local streets near US 101.

Two design alternatives have been evaluated in the draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration and Environmental Assessment and are being considered for approval.
