FULL CLOSURE OF STATE ROUTE 41 NEXT WEEK IN CHOLAME

SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY – A full closure of State Route 41 will take place on Wednesday, June 6 from 8 am to 5:30 pm for a pave and grind operation, guardrail repair and mowing. This closure will extend from Hwy. 46 East at the Cholame “Y” to State Route 33.

- Motorists headed **northbound** may continue east on Hwy. 46 to State Route 33 to State Route 41.
- Motorists headed **southbound** on State Route 41 may detour to State Route 33 to Hwy. 46.

Electronic message boards and detour signs will be posted to inform the public about this closure. The CHP will be on the scene to ensure the safety of motorists and highway workers. The public can expect the detour to last about 30-45 minutes depending on traffic conditions.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through construction zones.
