## ONE DAY MAINTENANCE PROJECT ON STATE ROUTE 236 BEGINS FRIDAY

**SANTA CRUZ COUNTY** – A one-day highway maintenance chip seal operation will **close** State Route 236 in Boulder Creek from Governor's Camp Road to just south of Via Paloma Road on Friday, August 10, Caltrans officials have announced.

RoadWork hours on this six-mile section will take place from 7:30 am to 7:30 pm on Friday only. A detour along Hwy. 9 will be posted and in effect.

**Local residents just south of Via Paloma Road will have access to their homes as the closure will end further south.**

This project consists of a pavement seal to improve the condition of the roadway.

**Caltrans reminds motorists to move over or slow down when driving through Caltrans work zones.**
