ONE-DAY PAVING OPERATION ON HIGHWAY 9 IN DOWNTOWN BOULDER CREEK ON WEDNESDAY ONLY—LONG DELAYS EXPECTED

SANTA CRUZ COUNTY— Caltrans will conduct a grind and pave operation on both directions of State Route 9 at the San Lorenzo River Bridge between Riverdale Blvd. and Monaco Lane just north of downtown Boulder Creek for one day only on Wednesday, May 30 from 7:30 am until 8 pm, Caltrans officials have announced (see map link below).

Roadwork consists of one-way reversing traffic control with flaggers. **Motorists can expect delays of 15-20 minutes.** Roadwork should be completed on the same day at night, Wednesday, May 30.

The purpose of this maintenance project is to increase the lifespan of this section of roadway.

Electronic message boards will be posted to alert motorists of this roadwork.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway construction zones.
