ONE-DAY CLOSURE FOR STRIPING OPERATION ON HIGHWAY 9 BETWEEN KEYSTONE WAY AND GLENGARRY ON WEDNESDAY ONLY—DETOUR IN PLACE

SANTA CRUZ COUNTY— Caltrans will conduct a striping operation in State Route 9 between Keystone Way in Santa Cruz and Glengarry Road in Felton for one day only on Wednesday, June 6 from 8 am until 2:30 pm, Caltrans officials have announced (see map link below).

Roadwork requires a full closure in both directions of this three-mile section of Hwy. 9 between Keystone Way and Glengarry Rd. **THE DETOUR WILL BE GRAHAM HILL ROAD.** Motorists can expect delays of up to 15 minutes but roadwork should be completed the same day.

Electronic message boards will be posted to alert motorists of this roadwork. The CHP will be present to assist with traffic control.

The purpose of this maintenance project is to increase the lifespan of this section of roadway, which is being performed by the Santa Cruz North maintenance crew.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway construction zones.
