

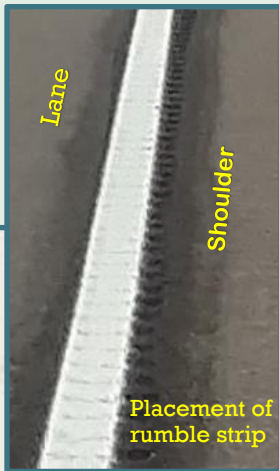
Highway 46 West – Edge Line Rumble Strip

Project Need

Highway 46 West has experienced a pattern of run off the road collisions.

Project Purpose

The purpose of the project is to reduce the number and severity of roadway departure collisions.



Proposed Work

Install rumble strips along the edge line at the outside shoulders from 0.1 mile east of Highway 1 to Theatre Drive. Rumble strips are a series of narrow indentations ground into the pavement. They alert inattentive or distracted drivers through vibration and noise. Typically, shoulders along Highway 46 West are 8 feet wide. Rumble strip will not be installed at driveways, intersections, or where the shoulder is less than 5 feet wide.



Funding

Construction Capital of \$645,000 is funded through the State Highway Operation and Protection Program.

Schedule

Plans, Specifications, & Estimates (PS&E): Spring 2017

Begin Construction: Late Fall 2017*

*There is a potential that funding will become available sooner and that construction could begin as early as Summer 2017.



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
