Hollywood Freeway (US 101) Pavement Project from Downtown Los Angeles to Hollywood

LOS ANGELES – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will continue to re-pave lanes on US 101 in Los Angeles, Friday, February 26. Closures will occur on Friday and Saturday nights, and Sunday mornings. Motorists should expect delays and consider alternate routes.

Upcoming Closures:
Friday, February 26 to Sunday, February 28
Northbound US 101, SR-110 to Alvarado Boulevard

The timeframes for the closures are as follows:

Fridays and Saturdays:

Up to one lane – Midnight to 9 a.m.

Up to two lanes – Midnight to 9 a.m.

Up to three lanes – Midnight to 7 a.m.

North- and southbound SR-110 connector to northbound US 101 – Midnight to 9 a.m.

Saturday and Sundays:

Up to one lane – Midnight to 10 a.m.

Up to two lanes – Midnight to 10 a.m.

Up to three lanes – Midnight to 8 a.m.

Northbound I-110 to northbound US 101 – Midnight to 10 a.m.

Southbound SR-110 to northbound US 101 – 7 p.m. to 1 p.m. (Saturday to Sunday)

Precast Jointed Concrete Pavement (PJCP) will be used at several locations within the project area. PJCP panels are cast and cured at a plant off-site and then trucked to the construction location and installed using a crane to help reduce closure times and maintenance costs.

This \$19.26 million project was awarded to OHL USA Inc. from Irvine, California. The project is funded by the State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) and is expected to finish by the end of 2016.

The California Highway Patrol will be on duty. Remember to **Be Work Zone Alert**.
