Pacific Coast Highway (SR-1) Maintenance Work

MALIBU – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close one northbound lane of Pacific Coast Highway (SR-1) from Winding Way to Ramirez Mesa Drive daily beginning Monday, December 13 through Friday, December 17, 7 a.m. until 2 p.m. to realign lanes and install k-rail. Lane closures are subject to change.

This work is part of a project to repair damaged drainage pipes and prevent slope erosion. As part of this project three to five oak trees may require pruning or removal. Any trees deemed necessary for removal will be replaced with native oak trees.

Peterson-Chase Construction, Inc. of Irvine, Calif. is the contractor on this \$220,000 project. The project is expected to complete by Spring 2011.
