SAN BERNARDINO FREEWAY (I-10) CLOSURES FOR RESTORATION

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close lanes and ramps for mainline, HOV (high occupancy vehicle or carpool) lane and ramp restoration on the San Bernardino Freeway (I-10), from the Golden State Freeway (I-5) to the San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605). One lane will remain open to traffic at all times; no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. The following schedule will be in effect, weather permitting:

Monday, March 23

Eastbound I-10

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to two lanes from Rosemead Boulevard to I-605
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – On- and off-ramps at Baldwin Avenue

Westbound I-10

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to two lanes from I-605 to New Avenue
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – On-ramps at Temple City Boulevard, Rosemead Boulevard, Walnut Grove Avenue, and Del Mar Avenue

Tuesday, March 24

Westbound I-10

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up two lanes and from Baldwin Park Avenue to Atlantic Boulevard
- 10 p.m. to 9 a.m. – On- and off-ramps at Rosemead Boulevard, Walnut Grove Avenue, San Gabriel Boulevard, Del Mar Avenue and New Avenue

Wednesday, March 25

Westbound I-10

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up two lanes and from Baldwin Park Avenue to I-710
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – On- and off-ramps at San Gabriel Boulevard, Del Mar Avenue, New Avenue, Garfield Avenue, Atlantic Boulevard, Fremont Avenue
- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Connectors to I-710

SAN BERNARDINO (I-10) LANE CLOSURE SCHEDULE

Thursday, March 26

Westbound I-10

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to two lanes and the carpool lane from I-605 to I-710
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – On- and off-ramps at Garfield Avenue, Atlantic Boulevard Fremont Avenue and Del Mar Avenue
- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Connectors to I-710

I-10 is a major thoroughfare serving commuters and large commercial vehicles. As a result of heavy use, the asphalt pavement in the carpool lanes has experienced extensive wear. New pavement will improve safety and mobility for motorists. Atkinson Construction is the contractor on this \$165 million project which is expected to complete spring 2011. Caltrans advises motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”

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
