Closures Scheduled for I-110 Project

Los Angeles - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Harbor Freeway (I-110) as part of a pavement project. One lane of traffic will remain open to motorists at all times. The following schedule of closures will be in effect, weather permitting:

Monday Night, November 3:

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to four lanes northbound I-110 between Redondo Beach Boulevard and Century Boulevard.

Nightly, Tuesday through Thursday, November 4-6:

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to four lanes of north- and southbound I-110 between Redondo Beach Boulevard and Century Boulevard.

Friday Night, November 7:

- 8 p.m. to 11 a.m. – up to four lanes of north- and southbound I-110 between Redondo Beach Boulevard and Century Boulevard.

Saturday Night, November 8:

- 8 p.m. to 12:00 p.m. – up to four lanes southbound I-110 between Century Boulevard and Redondo Beach Boulevard.
- 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. – up to four lanes northbound I-110 between Redondo Beach Boulevard and Century Boulevard.

J Mc Loughlin Engineering Company, Inc. is the contractor on this \$3.1 million project which will include pavement and loop detector work. Anticipated completion is summer 2009. Caltrans reminds you to “**Slow For the Cone Zone.**”
