CLOSURES THIS WEEK ON I-5 BETWEEN I-605 AND I-710

LOS ANGELES – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close various lanes on both directions of the Santa Ana Freeway (Interstate 5) between the San Gabriel River Freeway (Interstate 605) and the Long Beach Freeway (Interstate 710) **nightly** for sawcutting, replacing concrete slabs, repairing spalls and grinding/paving asphalt from Monday night January 26 through Sunday morning February 1 as follows:

Monday night (1/26) and Tuesday night (1/27):

NB I-5 between I-605 and I-710

- 10 p.m. to midnight – up to two of four lanes closed.
- Midnight to 5 a.m. – up to three of four lanes closed.

Wednesday night (1/28) and Thursday night (1/29):

N/B I-5 between I-605 and I-710

- 10 p.m. to midnight – up to two of four lanes closed.
- Midnight to 5 a.m. – up to three of four lanes closed.

S/B I-5, between I-710 and I-605

- 11 p.m. to 1 a.m. – up to two of four lanes closed.
- 1 a.m. to 5 a.m. – up to three of four lanes closed.

Fri. night (1/30):

NB I-5 between I-605 and I-710

- Midnight to 7 a.m. – up to three of four lanes closed.

S/B I-5, between I-710 and I-605

- Midnight to 8 a.m. – up to three of four lanes closed.

Sat. night (1/31):

SB I-5 between I-710 and I-605

- Midnight to 10 a.m. – up to three of four lanes closed.

These closures are related to a \$10 million pavement preservation project on I-5 from Interstate 605 to Interstate 710 which began in summer 2014 and will end in 2016. Security Paving is the contractor.
