### Lane Closures for I-5 High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) Lane Construction

Sylmar – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close the following lanes, ramps and connectors of the Golden State Freeway (I-5) as part of a \$41.6-million project to construct High Occupancy Vehicle, (HOV) lanes, on north- and southbound I-5 from State Route 118 (SR-118) to State Route 14 (SR-14):

#### Thursday, November 3 and Friday, November 4:

- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – southbound I-5 east- and westbound on-ramp at San Fernando Mission Boulevard
- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – southbound I-5 on-ramp at Brand Boulevard
- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – one lane northbound I-5 from SR-118 To Rinaldi Street
- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – northbound I-5 off-ramp at Brand Boulevard/Chatsworth Drive

#### Saturday night, November 5:

- Midnight to 6 a.m. – ALL LANES northbound I-5 from SR-118 to Rinaldi Street
- 7 p.m. to 10 a.m. – up to two lanes northbound I-5 from SR-118 to Rinaldi Street
- 7 p.m. to Noon – westbound SR-118 connector to northbound I-5
- 7 p.m. to Noon – northbound I-5 on-ramp at Paxton Street
- 8 p.m. to Noon – northbound I-5 off-ramp at Brand Boulevard/Chatsworth Drive
- 8 p.m. to Noon – northbound I-5 off-ramp at San Fernando Mission Boulevard
- 8 p.m. to Noon – northbound I-5 on-ramp at Laurel Canyon Boulevard
