SURVEY WORK AT RICHARDSON GROVE

Caltrans crews are scheduled to perform survey work on Route 101 in Humboldt County at Richardson Grove. The information from the survey will be useful to both Caltrans and State Parks and will include all roadway features (centerline, edge of traveled way, shoulders, bridges, culverts, etc.), as well as nearby structures and trees.

The survey crews have been specially trained to operate with minimal impacts within the park, and will be especially sensitive to the natural environment. They will not be marking, moving, or otherwise affecting any natural feature within the park. While the majority of the work will not be performed on the highway, Caltrans crews anticipate, for safety reasons, having one-way traffic control with 15-minute delays beginning Tuesday, June 27 through Thursday, June 29 from 9AM – 3PM.

The Digital Terrain Model produced from the survey will serve as a base for displaying additional information for future studies and projects to improve safety and mobility.
