PAVING ON ROUTE 29 FROM LOWER LAKE TO KELSEYVILLE IN LAKE COUNTY SUSPENDED UNTIL JULY 7

Eureka – Due to cool nighttime temperatures, Caltrans has temporarily suspended paving operations on a highway preventive maintenance project located on Route 29 from Lower Lake to Kelseyville in Lake County. The nighttime temperature has been dropping below 60 degrees, which is the minimum required for a chip seal coating to be applied to the current asphalt. In order to minimize impacts to traffic, most of the paving is being performed at night. It is anticipated that by July 7 the nighttime temperature will be warm enough for paving to resume, and be completed by the end of July.

In addition to paving, this project will place weed mat around guardrails to reduce future maintenance costs, and restripe the roadway. The project is anticipated to be completed by the end of August.
