ROAD REPAIR TO BEGIN ON ROUTE 101 IN CRESCENT CITY

Eureka – Caltrans announced today that a road repair project on Route 101 in and near Crescent City will begin on Friday, September 10. This \$2.7 million project will resurface portions of Route 101, including the portion between Ninth Street in Crescent City and Elk Valley Cross Road north of Crescent City. This maintenance project is necessary to extend the service life of the existing roadway and improve the driveability.

Construction is scheduled to begin on Friday, September 10, and is anticipated to be complete by the first week of November, weather permitting.

During scheduled work hours, traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction of travel. Motorists may experience minor traffic slowdowns.

- From Ninth Street to Parkway Drive, work hours are 8:00 PM to 7:00 AM, weeknights, beginning Friday, September 10.
- From Parkway Drive to Elk Valley Cross Road, work hours are anticipated to be from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Thursday, and 6:00 AM to 3:00 PM, Fridays, beginning Friday, September 17.

Please use caution and obey all traffic signs. We appreciate your cooperation and support. Please be assured we will work to minimize inconveniences you may experience during the course of this work.
