What is being planned?

Caltrans has evaluated a group of potential improvements to address the traffic calming and non-motorized concerns of the Hiouchi Community. These concepts will be documented in a Project Study Report that can be used in the future to compete for grant funding sources as they become available.

Why are we studying this Route for these types of improvements?

As part of Caltrans' commitment to recognizing communities needs and working with these communities as partners, Caltrans has initiated this project at the request of the Del Norte Local Transportation Commission.

What's being considered?

TRAFFIC CALMING IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE

- Traveled way narrowing, radar feedback signs, gateway monuments, optical speed bars, colorized shoulders and decorative street lighting

NON-MOTORIZED TRAFFIC IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE

- Bike lanes and sidewalks with decorative concrete surfaces (hardscaping) installations.
