

# James E. Roberts Memorial Bridge

Gateway to Yosemite and an economic cornerstone for Tuolumne County



**NIGHTLY CLOSURES**  
**UPDATE #5**  
**BEGAN OCTOBER 4, 2016**

The State Route 120/James E. Roberts Memorial Bridge project in Tuolumne County got under way in early July 2016. Workers will replace the bridge deck and retrofit the structure to provide an additional 40 years of service.

One way-traffic control is in effect and will be throughout the \$20.8 million project, which is scheduled to finish in November 2017. A portable signal is being used to manage traffic on the bridge and motorists are scheduled to wait no longer than 10 minutes.


The second phase of work will began on **Tuesday, October 4, 2016**, and the bridge is scheduled to close Sunday through Thursday nights from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. Crews will be replacing the bridge deck during these nightly repairs, which are scheduled to end in February 2017.

After the deck is installed, there will be a week-long, 24/7 closure to complete the joint seal repairs before it is opened to the public.

The project will provide a new bridge deck and railings, strengthen existing girders, improve the bridge's seismic strength, and reduce the need for frequent minor repairs
