## 16 – Day Full Closure of Westbound SR-91 Tustin Avenue On-ramp State Route 91 Lane Extension & Auxiliary Lane Reconstruction 02/12/16 through 02/29/16

**Irvine** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close the westbound SR-91 Tustin Avenue On-ramp in Anaheim for 16 consecutive days and 6 hours to place temporary k-rail, traffic screen and crash cushion, and reconstruct the On-ramp. The westbound SR-91 shoulder widening and Maintenance Vehicle Pullout (MVP) will also be done behind k-rail. Detours will be posted to alert motorists.
