State Route 91 Roadway Rehabilitation Project Week of January 21, 2013

Irvine—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will continue to grind, remove damaged concrete slabs and resurface off/onramps from the Los Angeles County to Anaheim. Alternate lane closures are scheduled late night through early morning hours. Detours will be posted to alert motorists. Consecutive ramps in the same direction of travel will not be closed. *Please note: 55 hour - Weekend Closure scheduled, Westbound SR-91 at Kraemer Boulevard/Glassell Street Offramp beginning Friday, January 25th at 10:00 p.m. through Monday, January 28th at 5:00 a.m..
