## State Route 91 Roadway Rehabilitation Project Week of October 15, 2012

**Irvine**—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will grind, stripe and remove damaged concrete slabs from Kraemer Boulevard, Anaheim to Knott Avenue, Buena Park. Alternate lane closures are scheduled late night through early morning hours. Detours will be posted to alert motorists.
