Winter Closure for the Following Rest Areas

REDDING – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 2 will close the LT Davis Safety Roadside Rest Area (SRRA) 37 miles east of Quincy on State Route 70, October 18th for inspection and repairs.

The LT Davis SRRA, is a seasonal rest area normally scheduled for winter closure; it will remain closed until April 2008.

The following seasonal SRRA's are also scheduled for winter closure:

November 1, 2007 through April 30, 2008.

- Hillcrest - 14 miles west of Burney on State Route 299, Shasta County
- Lake Almanor – 4 miles east of Chester on State Route 36, Plumas County

December 1, 2007 through March 31, 2008

- Shingletown – 4 miles east of Shingletown on State Route 44, Shasta County
- Massack – 7 miles east of Quincy on State Route 70, Plumas

Roadside signs will announce the closures and direct motorists to the next available rest stop.

District 2 maintains 19 Safety Roadside Rest Areas in the seven northern counties of Lassen, Modoc, Plumas, Shasta, Siskiyou, Tehama and Trinity.
