Evening Lane Closure for Dana to Downtown Project

REDDING – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) advises motorists of an upcoming closure of the eastbound number 2 lane on State Route 44 at the Dana to Downtown Project.

Crews will perform vegetation removal, roadway widening and placement of temporary K-rail from Park Marina onramp to the Sacramento River Bridge in preparation for future highway widening.

The closure will be in effect Monday – Friday between the hours of 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. beginning March 2.

All work will be carried out in the evening to limit traffic impacts. Construction noise and lights may inconvenience area residents. Schedule is subject to change due to weather.

The Dana to Downtown Project emerged from a 1997 study performed by Caltrans and sponsored by the Shasta County Regional Transportation Planning Agency and has consistently been rated by the RTPA as the highest priority transportation project in the Redding area and Shasta County. Fifty-four percent of the project is funded from State transportation revenues approved by the RTPA while the remaining 46 percent comes from State transportation revenues approved by Caltrans. The RTPA governing board consists of the three members of the Shasta County Board of Supervisors and four City Council members representing Redding, Anderson and the City of Shasta Lake.
