Public Workshop Scheduled for State Route 99 Draft Plan

LOS MOLINOS- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with the Tehama County Transportation Commission will host a public workshop on Monday, May 18, 2009 from 6:30 p.m. to 7:45 p.m. in the cafeteria at Lassen View School, 10818 Hwy 99 E, Los Molinos, CA 96055. The purpose of the event is to announce to community members that a draft of the State Route 99 Transportation Concept Report will be available on for review and comment. The report evaluates potential future conditions and management options for the route. Public comments received at the first workshop in March 2009 have been addressed during development of the draft report. Copies of the draft plan will be available after May 14, 2009 at: Tehama County Public Works Los Molinos Library, Los Molinos Chamber of Commerce, Umpqua Community Bank, and on the Internet at http://www.dot.ca.gov/dist2/planning/concept_rpts.htm.

Community participation is encouraged and will help guide future development of State Route 99 in Tehama County.
