CONSTRUCTION UPDATE FOR DANA TO DOWNTOWN PROJECT

REDDING – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 2 announces complete closure of the Sundial Bridge (Auditorium Drive) overcrossing on State Route 44 in Redding from 10 p.m. Thursday, June 11, 2009 to 6 a.m. Friday, June 12, 2009 and possibly 10 p.m. Friday June 12, 2009 to 6 a.m. Saturday morning June 13, 2009. The closure is necessary to complete placement of concrete for the new bridge.

Detours will be available and clearly marked. The on and off ramps to Sundial Bridge from SR 44 will remain open. Changeable Message Signs will be activated and motorists are encouraged to tune to AM 1610 (Highway Advisory Radio) for up to date information.

Similar work will also take place on June 25 and 26, 2009. Additional information about closure times will be made available closer to those dates.

Residents and businesses will also experience increased presence of equipment and an increase in noise during the closures as well as during the daytime hours of 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. during the month of June.
