### **State Route 44 closure postponed until Wednesday, possibly Thursday**

REDDING – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 2 had reported a closure of the eastbound number two lane (slow lane) on State Route 44 over the Sacramento River for Tuesday, June 23, 2009 in order to complete removal of a temporary retaining wall structure on the new bridge.

Due to scheduling conflicts, the date of the lane closure has been changed to Wednesday, June 24 or possibly Thursday, June 25 between 6 a.m. and 9 a.m.

Motorists are advised to drive with caution through the construction area and are reminded of the reduced speed limit to 45 mph. Caltrans appreciates your patience during this phase of construction. Please call the Public Information Office at 530-225-3260 for more information.
