## ONE-WAY TRAFFIC CONTROL ON STATE ROUTE 145 IN MADERA COUNTY

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces **Intermountain Slurry Seal Inc.** will conduct one way traffic control with flaggers this week along State Route 145 in Madera County as part of a pavement rehabilitation maintenance project.

Beginning tomorrow, Wednesday, September 16<sup>th</sup>, State Route 145 will be reduced to one way traffic control just west of Road 29 to just west of State Route 41 between the hours of 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. each day. It is anticipated that this project may be completed by Friday, September 18<sup>th</sup>. (Weather permitting) Closure schedule is subject to change due to contractor operations, or any unforeseen circumstance which may occur during construction operations.

The contractor will be conducting one way traffic control within the project limits and during the work hours listed above with the use of a pilot car and flagging personnel through the work zone. Commuters are reminded to obey flagging personnel and pay close attention to road construction vehicles and personnel at all times.

During flagging operations, delays can last for up to 10 minutes. Commuters are encouraged to avoid this area during work hours and use alternate routes if possible in order to avoid delays during the morning or afternoon commute times.
