## PAVEMENT REHABILITATION ON STATE ROUTE 168 CONTINUES NEXT WEEK IN SHAVER

**WHAT:** PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT ALONG BOTH DIRECTIONS OF STATE ROUTE 168 IN THE COMMUNITY OF SHAVER.

**WHEN:** MONDAY THRU FRIDAY, BEGINNING, OCTOBER 15<sup>TH</sup> FROM 7:00 A.M. UNTIL 7:00 P.M. (No weekend work)

**WHERE:** FRESNO COUNTY; IN/NEAR SHAVER AT VARIOUS INTERMITTENT LOCATIONS FROM NORTH OF CRESSMAN ROAD TO ROAD ENTRANCE TO CAMP EDISON.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that **Agee Construction Corporation** will continue to implement pavement rehabilitation operations on **State Route (SR) 168 in Fresno County next week, Monday, October 15th**. This \$1.3 million project consists of crack sealing; asphalt overlay operations and permanent striping along 6.2 miles of SR168. It is anticipated this project will be completed November 2012. **(Schedule subject to change due to weather, schedule, or unforeseen contractor operations).**

**Next week, the contractor will conduct various construction operations at intermittent locations within the project limits.** Construction operations with one way traffic control with flaggers and a pilot car will continue to be utilized. Motorists are advised reversing lane closures along State Route 168 are necessary in order to safely conduct construction operations. Motorists may experience up to a 15-minute traffic delay within construction areas along SR168 within the Shaver Lake community. Motorists are encouraged to use an alternate route or allow extra time to their daily commute.

**Motorists are advised to reduce speed and adhere to all construction signage. The safety of our maintenance and construction crews is very important, so please "Slow for the Cone Zone" and follow flagger and pilot car directions at all times.**

Portable Changeable Message Signs (PCMS) and lane closure signage will be used in order to safely notify motorists of upcoming closures.
