FULL CLOSURE OF EASTBOUND STATE ROUTE 180 CONNECTOR TO NORTHBOUND 41

WHAT: NIGHT TIME CLOSURE FOR CONCRETE BARRIER INSTALLATION

WHEN: FRIDAY EVENING, JUNE 27TH FROM 11:00 P.M. UNTIL 8:00 A.M. SATURDAY.

WHERE: WITHIN THE CITY OF FRESNO; EASTBOUND STATE ROUTE 180
CONNECTOR TO NORTHBOUND SR 41.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces construction crews will be installing a concrete barrier for the current on-going ramp metering project currently in construction at the eastbound State Route (SR) 180 connector to southbound SR 41.

In order to safely implement this project the following on-ramp will be closed on Friday evening, June 27th beginning at 11:00 p.m. until 8:00 a.m. Saturday morning in order to reduce commuter impacts to motorists during the weekly commute:

- **Eastbound State Route 180 connector ramp to northbound State Route 41**

These scheduled closures are subject to change due to any unforeseen circumstances that may occur during construction.

Portable message signage will be in place on advising motorists of the closures. Motorists are advised to watch for highway workers and to adhere to all closure signage.
