CALTRANS ANNOUNCES NEWEST CONSTRUCTION DATE FOR RAMP CLOSURE

WHAT: CONTINUOUS 30-DAY RAMP CLOSURE-NEW RAMP METERING PROJECT
WHEN: **NEW DATE:** TUESDAY, JUNE 3RD BEGINNING AT 5:00 A.M.
WHERE: CITY OF FRESNO; EASTBOUND STATE ROUTE 180 CONNECTOR RAMP TO SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 41

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and R & L Brosamer, Inc. advise motorists that the 30-Day extended closure of the eastbound State Route (SR) 180 connector ramp to southbound SR 41 has been rescheduled to begin Tuesday morning, June 3rd beginning at 5:00 a.m. and will re-open on Thursday, July 3rd.

This continuous full closure is necessary to allow the contractor to safely initiate and complete a new ramp metering system at this location. This improvement project will consist of installing a new ramp metering system, widening the existing ramp and installation of overhead electronic signage.

Changeable message signs and construction signage will be in place advising motorists of the ramp closure. Motorists are advised to avoid the area, use an alternate route or allow additional time to their daily commute. (Schedule subject to change due to weather or any unforeseen circumstances which may occur during construction).

Caltrans would like to thank the residents, businesses and commuters for their patience during this project. The public is reminded to drive with extra care while travelling through construction and maintenance projects at all times and to adhere to all posted signage. Please merge when directed to do so, be alert for contractor and Caltrans personnel and please ***“Slow for the Cone Zone.”***
