STATE ROUTE 198 AND 19th AVENUE BRIDGE SUPPORT INSTALLATION SCHEDULED FOR NEXT THREE WEEKS

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with Granite Construction, Inc. announces scheduled bridge support installation on State Route 198 and 19th Avenue, within the City of Lemoore in Kings County. This work is part of the current State Route 198 and 19th Avenue Interchange Project.

The following work is scheduled to begin February 10th, 2014 (weather permitting):

State Route 198 at 19th Avenue:

Crews will be working to install bridge supports on the north and south side of State Route 198 at 19th Avenue beginning February 10th, 2014 from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily. This work is scheduled to take place daily, Monday through Friday for approximately 3 weeks.

Bridge Support Installation work will involve the use of heavy equipment and a pile driver, therefore residents located near this location will experience elevated noise levels during these hours. Work may continue for longer periods of time each day if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during construction.

Left Turn Lanes are closed from both eastbound and westbound State Route 198 onto 19th Avenue and will remain closed throughout the duration of the project. The motoring public is encouraged to use Vine Street (18 ½ Avenue) and State Route 41 interchange as detours to access 19th Avenue when possible.

Please remember that local businesses located on 19th Avenue will remain open during construction and access to driveways will be maintained, so please continue your patronage.
