EASTBOUND STATE ROUTE 198 NIGHT CLOSURE AT 14TH AVENUE FOR PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces a scheduled closure of eastbound State Route 198 at 14th Avenue in Armona within Kings County as part of an ongoing pavement rehabilitation project between 14th Avenue and 11th Avenue in Hanford.

The following night closure is scheduled for tomorrow, Tuesday, August 12, 2014:

FULL FREEWAY CLOSURE on Tuesday night, August 12th, 2014; Eastbound State Route 198 will be closed at 14th Avenue between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

During this closure, eastbound State Route 198 will be closed at 14th Avenue while crews are working. Eastbound traffic will be detoured off of State Route 198 at the 14th Avenue exit, then back onto 198 utilizing the eastbound on ramp at 14th Avenue.

Flagging personnel will be on site to help direct traffic through the work zone. Commuters are reminded to obey flagging personnel and pay close attention to road construction vehicles and personnel.

Motorists may experience delays and are encouraged to take alternate routes whenever possible. Closures may continue for longer periods of time each night if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during construction.

Caltrans would like to thank the residents, businesses and commuters for their patience during this enhancement project. The public is asked to drive with extra care while traveling through the construction area and please **Slow of the Cone Zone**.
