**WHERE: ON STATE ROUTE 233, FROM WASHINGTON ROAD TO THE STATE ROUTE 233/99 SEPARATION.**

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that **Granite Construction** continues to implement highway improvement operations and will begin striping and stencil operations along State Route 233 within the City of Chowchilla this week. It is anticipated that striping operations will begin tomorrow and continue for approximately two days.

**The traveling public may experience delays during the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Tuesday-Friday. (Date and times subject to change due to unforeseen contractor operations).**

**Construction personnel will be on site to assist motorists through the project area. Motorists may experience delays in this area during this time frame. Motorists are asked to use an alternate route whenever possible.**
