ONE WAY TRAFFIC CONTROL ON STATE ROUTE 41 BEGINS OCTOBER 2ND IN KERN AND KINGS COUNTIES

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will conduct one-way traffic control on State Route 41 between the San Luis Obispo/Kern County line and State Route 33 for paving operations.

The following lane closure will begin October 2nd, weather permitting:

- One-way traffic control on SR 41 between the San Luis Obispo/Kern County line and State Route 33 **will occur on a weekly basis from Sunday evening through Thursday morning from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. each day.** These closures will occur weekly throughout the month of October, beginning **October 2nd through October 27th.**

Caltrans personnel will be conducting one way traffic control during this time with the use of flagging personnel and a pilot vehicle to escort traffic through the work zone. Commuters are reminded to obey flagging personnel, stay behind the pilot vehicle and pay close attention to road maintenance vehicles.

California Highway Patrol (CHP) will be on site assisting with traffic control. Motorists are expected to obey all traffic laws.
