CALTRANS ADVISES CONNECTOR CLOSURE NEXT WEEK DUE TO MAINTENANCE PROJECT

WHAT: CONCRETE SPALL REPAIR PROJECT REQUIRES CONNECTOR CLOSURE.
WHEN: MONDAY, MARCH 16TH, 2:30 P.M. UNTIL 5:30 P.M. (ONE DAY)
WHERE: CITY OF FRESNO; NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 41 CONNECTOR TO NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces maintenance personnel will conduct concrete spall repair operations requiring the complete closure of the northbound SR 41 connector to northbound State Route 99. In order to safely complete this project, this connector will be closed from 2:30 p.m. until 5:30 p.m. on Monday afternoon, March 16th. **(Schedule is subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances or early completion of repairs which may occur during maintenance operations.)**

Portable changeable message signs (PCMS) will be activated south of the project limits notifying motorists of upcoming connector closure. Motorists are encouraged to avoid the area or use an alternate route whenever possible.

Caltrans would like to thank motorists for their patience during this maintenance project. The public is reminded to be alert for Caltrans personnel and to merge when directed to do so. The safety of our motorists' and work crew personnel is most important, therefore, please stay work zone alert and "***Slow for the Cone Zone***" in all Construction and Maintenance Zones at all times.
