STATE ROUTE 41 TO BE REDUCED TO ONE LANE EACH DIRECTION BETWEEN GRANGEVILLE AND HANFORD-ARMONA RD

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with Teichert Construction will reduce State Route 41 to one lane in each direction between Grangeville Boulevard and Hanford-Armona Road in Kings County as part of a current pavement rehabilitation project.

The following closure is scheduled to take place this week beginning on Thursday, September 13, 2012:

The current Northbound lanes of State Route 41 between Grangeville Boulevard and Hanford-Armona Road will be closed beginning at approximately 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 13, 2012, in order to rehabilitate pavement and widen shoulders.

The existing Southbound State Route 41 lanes will serve as the primary two-lane highway with one lane in each direction. This closure will last approximately six months while work on the closed section is being completed.

Businesses on the east side of State Route 41 will remain open and access will be maintained during construction.

Caltrans Construction workers remind you to drive with extra care and allow additional travel time while travelling within the project area. Please be alert for Construction Personnel and **“Slow for the Cone Zone.”**
