SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 41 LANE AND RAMP CLOSURE NEXT WEEK

WHAT: MAINTENANCE LANDSCAPE PROJECT REQUIRES LANE AND ON-RAMP CLOSURE.

WHEN: NEXT WEEK, TUESDAY, MARCH 18TH THRU FRIDAY, MARCH 21ST FROM 9:00 A.M. UNTIL 3:00 P.M. EACH DAY.

WHERE: CITY OF FRESNO; SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE (SR) 41 FROM BULLARD TO BARSTOW AVENUE/ALONG STATE ROUTE 41 EMBANKMENT.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that landscape personnel will implement landscape vegetation trimming and clean-up operations along the southbound SR 41 shoulder/embankment during regular daytime hours.

The Bullard Avenue southbound on-ramp and the #3 lane (closest to the shoulder) from Bullard to Barstow avenues will be closed in order to safely implement these operations. Workdays and times are subject to change due to weather, early completion of operation efforts or unforeseen circumstances that may occur with equipment, etc. Motorists are advised that no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time.

Caltrans would like to thank the residents, businesses and commuters for their patience during this maintenance improvement project. The public is reminded to drive with extra care while travelling through maintenance and construction projects at all times and to adhere to all posted signage.
