STATE ROUTE 43 ONE WAY TRAFFIC CONTROL IN KINGS COUNTY SCHEDULED FOR MONDAY

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with San Joaquin Valley Railroad (SJVR) announces scheduled lane closures in Kings County on State Route 43 on Monday to allow crews to conduct railroad crossing maintenance and pavement rehabilitation operations.

The following closures are as scheduled:

State Route 43 will be reduced to one-way traffic control from just north of Lacey Blvd to just north of the SJVR railroad crossing on **Monday, August 3rd, 2015** between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Signal lights at Lacey and the 198 interchange will be on flash mode during maintenance hours.

Crews will be conducting one way traffic control during this time with the use of flagging personnel and a pilot vehicle to escort traffic through the work zone. Commuters are reminded to obey flagging personnel, stay behind the pilot vehicle and pay close attention to road maintenance vehicles.

Closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during maintenance. This scheduled closure will occur, weather permitting. Motorists can expect delays and are encouraged to take an alternate route if possible.
