STATE ROUTE 46 ONE-WAY TRAFFIC CONTROL TOMORROW IN KERN COUNTY

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces one way traffic control tomorrow on State Route 46 and the Interstate 5 interchange in Kern County as part of a Pavement Rehabilitation Project. Crews will be grinding roadway and conducting pavement operations in areas of the eastbound lanes.

The following lane closures will be in effect tomorrow:

State Route 46 (Paso Robles Highway) will be reduced to one way traffic control tomorrow, Wednesday, April 30th, 2014 between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Closures will take place beginning just east of Interstate 5 and extend to just west Interstate 5 in Kern County.

Northbound and Southbound on and off ramps at Interstate 5 will remain open, however significant back up on these ramps is anticipated. Pavement operations are necessary during daytime hours due to low nighttime temperatures and for the safety of workers and motorists.

Construction Crews will be conducting one way traffic control at this location and during the work hours listed above with the use of flagging personnel through the work zone. Commuters are reminded to obey flagging personnel and pay close attention to road construction vehicles and personnel at all times.

During construction operations, delays can last for up to 30-45 minutes. Commuters are encouraged to avoid this area during project work hours and use alternate routes if possible. Closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during road construction procedures.
