ONE-WAY TRAFFIC CONTROL CONTINUES FOR PAVEMENT OPERATIONS IN MADERA COUNTY

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that contractor **Northwest Paving** continues to implement one-way traffic control operations at multiple locations along State Route (SR) 49 and SR 41 in Madera County. The contractor is currently completing pavement chip seal operations including the placement of reflectors within the center-line as part of a pavement rehabilitation project scheduled to be completed by the end of the month. Portable Changeable Message signs will be placed within the project limits notifying motorists to expect delays.

The following schedule is currently in place for this week and next.

Monday through Friday from 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. flaggers and pilot car(s) will direct traffic along State Routes 41 and SR 49. Final striping operations within these locations will follow after grinding/paving/reflector placement operations are complete.

Commuters are reminded to obey flagging personnel and pay close attention to road construction vehicles and personnel at all times. It is anticipated that motorists will be subject to 10-minute delays during construction.

Motorists who are delayed at driveways and intersections will be required to wait for pilot car and adhere to all signage in order to safely proceed through the work zone.

Commuters are encouraged allow additional time to their morning or afternoon commute in order to avoid delays. Closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during road construction activities.
