ONE-WAY TRAFFIC CONTROL ON STATE ROUTE 63 IN ORANGE COVE CONTINUES

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) reminds motorists that **AGEE Construction Inc.** continues to conduct one-way traffic control operations for a highway resurfacing improvement project near Orange Cove along State Route (SR) 63 in Fresno County.

One-way traffic control along SR 63 remains in effect until August 2015; it is anticipated that this project will complete within 20-working days.

Next week, Monday, August 3rd until Friday, August 7th lane closures will continue along both directions of SR 63 from the Tulare/Fresno County line to Avenue 408.

State Route 63 in Fresno County continues to be subject to one-way reversing traffic control utilizing flagging personnel. Operations will take place Monday-Friday between the hours of 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. each day until project completion.

Commuters are reminded to obey flagging personnel and pay close attention to road construction vehicles and personnel at all times.

During these operations, delays can last for from 10- 15 minutes. Commuters are encouraged to avoid this area during work hours and use alternate routes if possible. Closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to delays caused by uncontrollable events that may occur during construction.
